It is the way to Zojila pass and Zero point and is one of the main Indian Army camps. Kargil is also well known as NH1. Sonmarg is at an altitude of 18950 ft. This is called Zero point because it's almost 0 degrees Celsius every time. Reaching there is very risky as both the sides of the road from Sonmarg to Zero points are covered with ice. Above Zero points there is a glacier from where our Indian army soldiers guard our country.


Sonmarg to Zero Point



Shankaracharya Temple

This is the Lord Shiva temple founded by Saint Adi Shankara. This is a very old temple well-preserved and maintained under CRPF. There were many attacks for destroying it which resulted in more vigilance from the security point of view. Every worshipper is checked before entering the temple and you cannot take anything inside it. It is situated at the top of a hill of about 20 feet. So, worshippers have to climb 243 steps to enter the temple. There is a cave beside the temple where Shankaracharya did Tapasya. From the top of the hill, one can have a vista of marvellous Srinagar city and Dal Lake.
